

Williams Township Board of Supervisors

December 6, 2017

A special meeting of the Williams Township Board of Supervisors, 655 Cider Press Road, Easton, PA 18042 was held on the above date and called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Mark Ernst. Mark led the audience in the pledge to the flag. Others present were Vice Chairman Ray Abert, Supervisor George Washburn, Township Solicitor Jonathan Reiss, Township Manager Jennifer Smethers and Township Secretary Melody Ernst.

New Business

1. Tax Collector Compensation – Resolution 2017-24 – Jonathan stated the Board previously asked him to draft a Resolution in case no one was elected as Tax Collector. Resolution 2017-24 states that as a result of the election held on November 7, 2017 there were two write-ins for the position of Tax Collector. It also states that one write-in candidate was not qualified due to lack of voter registration and the other write-in vote declined the position on November 22, 2017. On November 22, 2017 a vacancy was created as Williams Township Tax Collector. It further sets the compensation for year 2018 and annually will be at a fixed rate of \$4.00 per bill and states that the Tax Collector is authorized to collect a tax certification fee of \$25.00 per certification. It also states that the Township will provide office space in a Township owned facility. The Resolution will become effective on January 1, 2018. George made a motion to approve Resolution 2017-24, second by Ray. There being no comments, motion carried 3-0.
